Points to Ponder at Life Group:

- 1. Process this multi-part question about glory as a group.
 - Have each person in your group write down a definition of glory. Share your definitions.
 - Share how you arrived at your definition, reflecting on how your definition has (or perhaps has not) changed through different seasons of your life.
 - Work through the following passages in Exodus: 14:15-18, 15:11, 16:10-18, 24:15-18, Exodus 33:18-19, 40:34-38. How does your definition of glory hold up? How do you want to change it?
 - Finish the statement together based on your discussions: Glory is...
- 2. The sermon described how Martin Luther King Jr. experienced something that caused him to lose sight of the glory. He had a good friend named Joan Baez, who ministered to him. In the safe space of your group, share what in your life is blocking your view of the glory. Allow the group to share with you an aspect of Christ's gospel that speaks to the situation.
